Park Play will replace the helicopter (Tiger Town). Will be looking into warranty.

Commissioner Gault contacted Attorney Tonya Rogers at Baker, Dublikar, Beck, Wiley and Mathews to inquire about legal representation for the park.

Commissioner Gault will reach out to Superintendent Kevin Spicher and the Howland School Board about additions to the baseball and softball fields regarding insurance.

Working with Cyclops Technology Group to design the tower that will hold the cameras and also have acceptable park aesthetics.

Minuteman Press is working on signage to duplicate the existing signage at the township kiosk entering the boardwalk. Boy Scout Ben James stated that he will be finishing the Disc Golf kiosk in the spring. When complete, roof will be attached.

Commissioners wish to thank Brad Silvers and his team for designing and implementing the Disc Golf Course at the park. The Commissioners remarked there has been a great deal of play already on the course. In the spring, Disc Golf will be added to the website.


Discussion was had by Commissioners about what to do with Basketball Court area for next year.
