**Summary of meeting:**

Jack Hineman, representing Trumbull County Master Gardeners: Water needs turned on at Bolindale Park. Maintenance Foreman Terry McDowell will take care of that. Master gardeners has scheduled an open house and tour of the Community Gardens on June 22 from 6-8. Four picnic tables are being built by the Boy Scouts and two will go by the garden and two by the pickleball courts.

Commissioner Shawn Pompelia: There will be a 2 week delay in the opening of the Bolindale pickleball courts due to the resurfacing. Courts will be opened by Mid-May, after the resurfacing is completed and weather permitting. The two new pickleball courts and volleyball court being built in the Howland Township Park are scheduled to be completed in June, weather permitting. They will be located where the basketball court was previously.

Two new signs are needed for the Howland and Bolindale pickleball courts and have been ordered.

Rob Dietl, representing Cyclops Technology: additional camera systems will be installed at various points in the Howland Township Park to help combat the ongoing vandalism. They will be installed and operational by June 1. Howland Rotary has donated \$1,470 towards the cost of the cameras. We are seeking advertising to further offset the cost of the cameras; the cameras will have the ability to display the advertising on them.

Commissioner Shawn Pompelia: The Howland Township Park is hosting an AAC High School cross country meet on October 14, in collaboration with the Howland Cross Country Coaches. The park will be closed for this event.
