

SUMMARY OF MEETING

September 19, 2025

Carrie Biery presented information on "Logan's Landing Project" which is to provide an area of the playground that is more sensory friendly and accessible equipment (inclusive playground). Looking at getting grants and fundraising for donations. Currently Cafaro has shown interest in and also have a few grant writers that are going to help. I have applied for about \$50,000 and currently have \$8,000 in the bank. Approximate cost would be between \$200,000 to \$300,000. Suggested a custom air plane that could be built by the community. Base could be artificial turf and a fence surrounding the area. Fence posts could be purchased and donor's name on. Suggested area also would be the basketball court. Proposals cover all costs (installation, drainage, freight, PIP surfacing and equipment). Will put on web site to start the fundraising.

Pickleball courts will be closed as of November 1st along with the main parks bathrooms.

October 13th the Commissioners will meet at Orwig Park to put up tree lights.

November 29th, from 4:30 pm to 6 PM, will be the Tree Lighting at Orwig Park.
