



Meeting Summary 6/6/2025

A recent request to have a pickle ball tournament was discussed by the Commissioners. Commissioners decided to only allow non-profit organizations to use the pickleball courts for tournaments.

Commissioner Gault received an inquiry in regards to purchasing a park bench. Commissioner Gault will check into the current price of a bench, pad and installation.

Property owners located at the east side of the park reached out about flooding issues. Commissioner Pompelia discussed that he is requesting quotes to alleviate the problem of flooding along with the drainage issues where the cross-country course floods.

Commissioner Pompelia stated that he has reached out for a quote from Sure Line to turn the old basketball court into a pickle ball court.

Commissioner Pompelia stated that Southside Escavating will start to alleviate drainage issues by the volley ball court.

Commissioner Pompelia discussed getting quotes for paving of an area of the park road in conjunction with Howland Township's paving program.

Commissioner Gault reviewed Morgandale Park playground equipment. She stated that the equipment seems to be in good shape and that some weeds will need taken care of. Commissioner Gault spoke with Administrator Pantelone about removing equipment and possibly reaching out to Believer's Church to help in upgrading Morgandale Park.

Commissioner Gault discussed a branch near the cornhole area, next to the Rotary Pavilion, that needs trimmed.

Commissioner Gault reviewed part of the Tiger Town surface material that had been replaced once and again there are spots all throughout the surface that had been replaced. . Commissioner Gault will reach out to our legal representative and ask to file a lawsuit to have it replaced.
